Tournament Notes: July tournament @ Falcon, weigh-in time for both days are at 2 pm. Coming into the hottest months of the year, it is very important to make sure your fish are taken care of and kept alive before and after weigh-ins. A few tips on helping keep fish alive in live wells: put two (2) 10 lb bags of ice in each live well before you go out—DO NOT FILL UNTIL YOUR FIRST WEIGH FISH GOES INTO THE WELL. Put a cap full of peroxide then 1.5 capfuls "catch and release" in your live well – depending on how early a fish is caught you may need to repeat, be sure to check fish throughout the day. WORD OF ADVICE: DO NOT ADD WATER TO YOUR WELLS THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS THAT NEGATES KEEPING THE WATER COOL! RECIRCULATE (MANUAL—ON ALL DAY—NO TIMERS!).
