Eight out of ten clubs were represented. Treasurer's report: Balance forward \$21,522.69. Expenses: Donation to ARC, \$200.00; donation to Boysville, \$200.00; and General Liability Insurance, \$1.051. Ending balance: \$20,071.69.

4<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> place - \$100.00, and every other 7<sup>th</sup> slot afterward will receive \$100.00 (up to 131<sup>st</sup> place).

The last five places with a fish weighed will win \$50.00 each.

Brenda asks each club for one volunteer to help at the tournament. (David Glenney is UCBC's Volunteer). A couple of items that Brenda stressed were: 1. Make sure your rig and trailer are parked within the lines, if you launch at Diablo East. 2. Read your Entry Forms closely for weigh-in times Saturday and Sunday, 3. METRO is using mesh bags for weigh-in...keep your fish in that bag in your livewell until you pull up to the scale.

## **TABC REPORT:**

The State Tournament is the last weekend in September at Sam Rayburn Reservoir. All functions will take place at the Umphrey Family Pavilion. Friday Sept. 27, registration begins at 4:00 PM and ends at 7:30. Next, at 7:31, the Captain's Meeting will begin. The meal Saturday night is at the Umphrey, weigh-in both days is at the Umphrey, and the Awards ceremony Sunday afternoon will be there, also. The main problem encountered, this year, is that the Chamber of Commerce is only allowing for the use of the Pavilion, but TABC is having to pay for the meal....\$4,000.00 (an item that used to be paid for by the C of C. UCBC still needs to pay for the entry fee for this event.

\*TABC has added a separate Ladies division, and a separate Junior Division (18 years old and under) for club members that are <u>not</u> in the Top 8...and there is <u>no entry fee</u>. The winners of each Division will win a Trophy. Go to the TABC website to get registered for this.
