OLD BUSINESS:

UCBC Fundraiser Fish Fry: Fish Fry is scheduled for Aug. 3, 2013 at the Schertz VFW.

Kris Hunter and Fred Beard are working hard on details. Fred reported that Meal Ticket money needs to be turned in. We will sell pre- paid tickets, again, and Kris Hunter will handle this. Meal Tickets will also be for a door prize the night of the fish fry (a 32 inch color flat screen TV). Randi Wayland is operating the jelly bean jar; Dolline Holmes is serving, and needs more people to help in the serving line; Jeff Mergele will arrange for an auctioneer; Dottie and David Glenney are running the bake sale; Dave Cole is the Finance Manager; Robin McFarlane is organizing the Auction items; Scott Hutzler is in charge of clean-up, and will need helpers; Brian Hunter is the “Head Cook”; Chris Short is providing the P. A. System, and will be the main computer operator. Kids Activities, such as Face-painting, will be provided.
