#### Fishing regulations for OH Ivie

#### **Black Bass**

For largemouth bass there is no minimum length limit, only two largemouth bass less than 18 inches may be retained each day

<u>For smallmouth bass</u> (if present) minimum length limit=14 inches. No minimum length Limit on Alabama, Guadalupe and spotted bass.

Daily bag limit for all black bass species is 5 in any combination.

Sunfish-Sunfish for UCBC tournament cannot be weighed in.
